As an IB World School, CREC's Metropolitan Learning Center is committed to providing a rigorous, internationally-regarded academic program that prepares students for college and career in a global economy. Units of study are grounded in global concepts that challenge students to learn by keeping the world in mind. It also challenges students to delve more deeply by applying what they learn to real-world situations.
